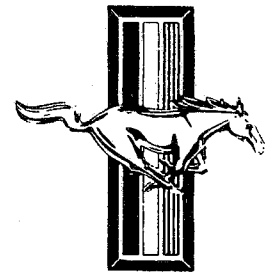

THE SECOND ANNUAL NATIONAL MEET

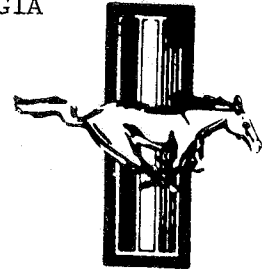
