



Dick Fleming of Newton, Iowa purchased this 1966 blue and white Shelby (#6S2169) in 1969. Restoration of the car was completed in the early 1980's by Bob Ash. Dick not only shows the Shelby, but also drives it in autocross races. Equipment includes a 4-speed transmission and 10-spoke aluminum wheels.

Neptune, New Jersey is home to this 1968 Sunlit Gold convertible. Evereste Newton states that the car now has over 137,000 miles on it and still runs better than any 1985 model. Some of the latest refinements made include a hand fitted 8000 rpm Sun tach in the location of the original clock and the addition of a rectangular digital clock to the center panel.

Father and son, Gregory and Jeff Bechtel of Boyertown, Pennsylvania are both members of the 1st Pennsylvania Mustang Club and owners of these two early model fastbacks.

The Medium Blue 1966 fastback is owned by Gregory. Although still under restoration, a lot of TLC has brought this fastback a long way since being located in an old barn in the Boyertown area.

Jeff is owner of the Wimbledon White 1965 fastback. Although this is not an original GT 350 Jeff states it turns a few heads more than once. The 289 2V is loaded with Cobra goodies.
