THE LIFE AND TIMES OF A NATIONAL DIRECTOR

What exactly is the role of a National Director? This question has been raised by several regional groups who are electing new officers. Since the position of national director for the regional groups is not covered in the National by-laws, there is a definite need for information.

Once a regional group has been chartered by MCA, a board of directors must be elected. This is also a good time to elect a national director for the group. This person serves as a representative for both the regional group and the National Club.

Each month the national directors receive a copy of the National Club meeting minutes and financial statements. This information should be shared with the membership of the group so everyone will stay informed as to the activities of the officers and National Board of Directors. If the group has any questions, suggestions, or problems, the national director for the group can relay the necessary information to National Headquarters for appropriate action. On the other hand, whenever the National Club needs information, etc., from a regional group, contact will probably be made through the national director for the group.

Directors are also notified of any new items offered through the National Club such as posters, judging rule booklets, calendars, or additional new accessories. The directors can then present this information to the group for consideration.

All too often National Headquarters is made aware of the fact that some directors are lax in fulfilling their duties. Numerous regional groups are totally unaware of the activities of the National Board of Directors. If your group does not presently have a national director, take the time to elect someone you feel will be willing to properly handle the job.

All directors and all MCA members are welcome to attend National Board of Directors meetings whenever possible. These meetings are always held the second Tuesday of each month. For additional information as to time and location, contact National Headquarters.
