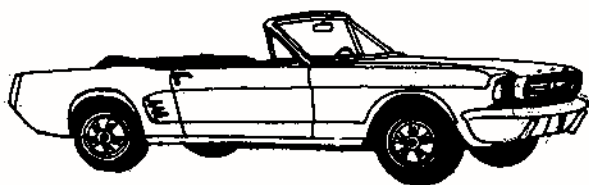





### MUSTANG PEDAL CAR PARTS

Illustrated is the original Mustang Pedal Car, it was manufactured for Ford Motor Company from 1964-1965, as part of the promotional material developed for the first full size Mustang car. Approximately 100,000 units were sold at \$12.95 ea. through local Ford dealers. Very few of the originals have survived.

AMF the manufacturer continued to manufacture the car, however, with changes in the decoration, the Ford label was dropped, the hubcaps changed, and in 1968 the steel steering wheel was replaced with a plastic wheel. In 1969, side scoops were added, and the same year a "T" handle shifter was used.



**LABEL SET INCLUDES:** 1) license plate, 2) Mustang nose scoop, 3) 535, 4) Mustang F O R D that goes across the hood, 5) labels are self adhesive.

Hubcaps, emblems, tail lights, side scoops are when plated just like the originals.
