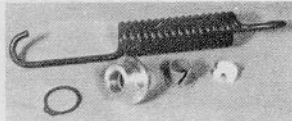

The principals of Tracktime believe you have covered our schools more completely than anyone else has to date and for that we are truly appreciative. We are looking forward to receiving reprints of the article.

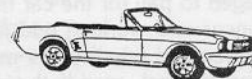
Many people who have asked for an explanation of what we do were pleased to read the article and have our whole concept explained with such a balance of good journalism and humor.
