New Product Offers Front-End Protection

Automobile front-end protection from road debris is a rapidly growing market. Soft bra covers sold in record numbers in 1988, estimated at 1.2 million units with dramatic growth expected to continue.

Carbrella Products, a division of Innovations Research Company in Denver, CO., has developed an automotive Fairing targeted at this growing market.

The Fairing is a high-impact plastic shell molded to the exact frontal design of each automobile. The development goal was to provide maximum damage protection without scratching or tarnishing the painted surfaces, which reportedly occurs frequently with soft bras.

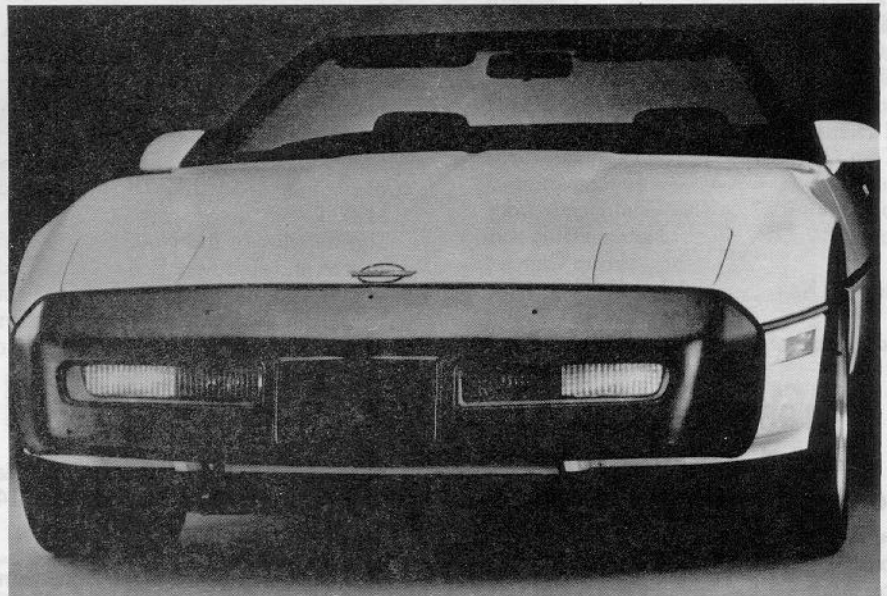
Automotive Farings can be driven through most car washes and do not require maintenance and continual readjustment, according to Matt Daily, director of corporate communications for the company.

"Additionally, a Fairing will deflect large and small road debris that would normally penetrate conventional soft bras."

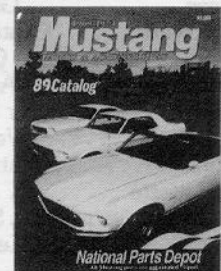
