

Saleen Names New SCCA Team Manager

ANAHEIM, CA. — Saleen Autosport has announced the appointment of a new manager for its SCCA team.

Peter Magnusson joins Saleen from the Newman / Sharp organization. His experience ranges from SCCA Trans Am to the IMSA Showroom Stock Series.
