## Ponies Bring High Prices At Indianapolis Auction

Muscle cars appeared to be popular models for buyers at the second annual Greater Indianapolis Collector Car Auction held in Indianapolis last month. Kruse International conducted the event, and Joe Sexon and Jack Martin of Sexton Companies in Indianapolis were the local sponsors.

"All the predictions about muscle cars are becoming reality," said auctioneer Mitchell Dr. Kruse.

"Thanks to investors like Reggie Jackson (who recently purchased 30 high performance cars for \$1 million), the market is skyrocketing. Most of the cars are still in the price bracket that many car enthusiasts can afford."

Highlighted prices on the high performance cars included \$11,750 for a 1967 Mustang GTA and \$33,000 for a 1968 Mustang Shelby GT500.

By comparison, a 1965 Pontiac GTO brought \$9,500 and a 1970 Chevelle convertible drew a bid of \$11,500.

Nearly 300 collector cars crossed the block, raising bids to about \$3 million. Kruse International says about 60 percent of the cars went to new owners.

"There was a high sale percentage of quality cars at Indianapolis," Kruse said. "We anticipate a 500-car event next year."

Indianapolis '89 attracted a weekend crowd of about 3,500 people, including Rik Smits, center for the Indianapolis Pacers. Smits bought a 1959 Cadillac convertible for \$21,500.
