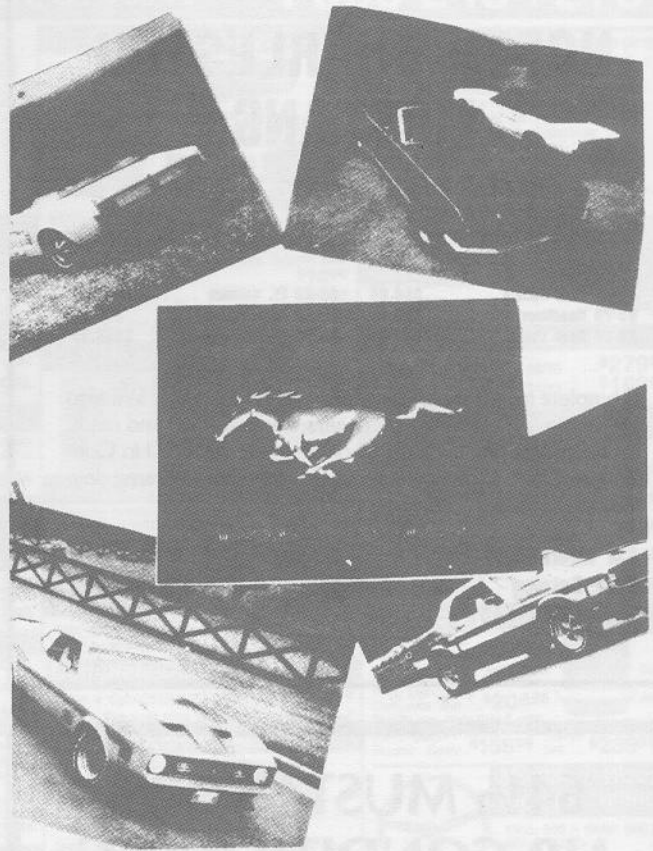
**Charlotte, NC**

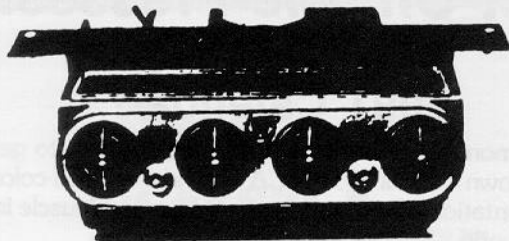
