

MCA National Show Deadlines Changed

The Board of Directors of the Mustang Club of America voted at its June meeting to change the deadlines for 1992 national and grand national shows.

All regional groups interested in sponsoring 1992 Grand National MCA Shows must have all application forms filed with MCA by February 1.

All groups interested in hosting 1992 National MCA Shows must have application forms filed by March 1.

Previously, Grand National and National Show applications were due in June and July.

The decision to move the 1992 show deadlines up came as a result of complaints from regional groups who are finding it necessary to book show sites as much as a year in advance.

"We're making this change to permit our regional groups to book show sites at least a year in advance. It is becoming increasingly difficult to schedule a show site — particularly indoor sites — without a minimum of one year's notice," said National Show Coordinator Bill Dillard.

Applications for 1991 Grand National Shows will be considered at the MCA's July meeting of the board of directors. Applications for 1991 national shows will be reviewed at the August board meeting.

Grand National events are awarded one month in advance of national shows to permit groups which may not be approved for Grand National events to have their applications reconsidered as National Shows.

A number of applications for Grand National and National Shows for the 1991 season have already been received by MCA.

Applications for MCA-approved Grand National and National Shows are available from Dillard and may be obtained by writing him in care of MCA, P.O. Box 447, Lithonia, GA 30058.

All applications for MCA-sanctioned national events must be filed on forms provided by the national organization, and groups applying for national shows must abide by a few stipulations set by the board of directors.

During the 1990 season, national shows were awarded to regional groups in Greenville, SC, Lake Charles, LA, and Overland Park, KS. A dual Grand National will be held over Labor Day Weekend. The Eastern Grand National will be sponsored by the First Pennsylvania Mustang Club and will be held in Lake Harmony, PA. The Western Grand National will be held in Albuquerque, NM. Host club for the Albuquerque show is the Rio Grande Mustang Club.

All applications for Grand National Shows for the 1991 season will be reviewed by the MCA board at its meeting in July. The meeting will be held July 10 at the Marriott Courtyard Motel at Windy Hill Road and I-75 in Marietta, GA, beginning at 7:30 p.m.

All applications for National MCA Shows will be reviewed at the board's August

meeting, which will be held at the same location on August 14.

Grand National show sites for 1991 will be announced in the August issue of **Mustang Times**. National show sites will be announced in the September issue.

All MCA board meetings are open to any MCA member who wishes to attend.


