

# '92 Show Application Deadlines Revised

Regional groups affiliated with The Mustang Club of America should begin requesting applications for 1992 national and grand national shows immediately, according to National Show Coordinator Bill Dillard.

Dillard says the MCA board of directors has changed the deadlines for 1992 shows to make it more convenient for regional groups to schedule show sites:

"The board took this action because our regional groups are finding it impossible to book suitable show sites without at least a year's advance notice," Dillard said.

Deadline for 1992 grand national shows have been moved to February 1 and deadlines for national show applications have been moved to March 1.

Previously, grand national show applications were due in June and national show applications in July for the following year.

"We hope this change will benefit our regional groups who are interested in hosting MCA events," President Charles Hampton said. "Our goal in making this change is to serve the needs of our regional groups who simply need more time to plan for these events."

All applications for national MCA events must be submitted to the board on forms provided by the national organization. Clubs interested in receiving forms for applying for grand national or national shows should contact Dillard in care of The Mustang Club of America, P.O. Box 447, Lithonia, GA 30058.
