Grand National Drew 214 Participants

A total of 214 cars were judged at the MCA 1991 Grand National held in Kingsport, TN August 16-18.

The show, sponsored by the First Tennessee Regional Group, was held at the Kingsport Civic Auditorium.

In addition to the 214 judged cars, there

were 36 cars in the Pony corral and 49 vendors attended.

The event began with early registration and a hospitality party Friday evening at the Ramada Inn. Registration and tech inspection resumed at 7 a.m. Saturday morning at the show site and judging, which began at 10 a.m., was completed Saturday afternoon. Trophies were presented at a Saturday evening awards banquet.

Members of the First Tennessee Regional Group estimate that more than 5,000 spectators attended the show.

Greg Home was show director for the event and Mike Bacon and Don Cox shared the duties of head judge.

Don and Delphia Cox were in charge of hospitality, Johnny and Chuck McClellan supervised parking, Bob and Margaret Davis handled registration and Paul Curtis and Brian Brinser were in charge of trophies and plaques. John Dunnivant was facilities chairman and Brian Morelock headed the program advertising committee.

The First Tennessee Regional Group was formed in November, 1976, and is celebrating its 15th anniversary. The group has hosted several National and Grand National Shows, including the 1984 Grand National.

Current membership of the First Tennessee Regional Group is 61.

MCA President Charles Hampton commended the First Tennessee Regional Group for its handling of the 1991 MCA Grand National. "As usual, this group did an outstanding job in organizing a tremendous show," Hampton said.
