

1993 MCA Show Deadlines Rapidly Approaching

Deadlines for applications for 1993 MCA-sanctioned National and Grand National shows are nearing, and MCA National Show Coordinator and Vice President Bill Dillard is urging all regional groups interested in applying for 1993 dates to contact him immediately.

"The 1993 show deadlines were changed earlier this year by the board of directors at my request. I felt that last year's deadlines came a little early (February and March) and made it difficult for regional groups to apply in time," Dillard said.

He noted that most MCA regional groups elect new officers in November, December and January of each year and the deadlines established for 1992 shows "didn't give the new officers time to put together a package and submit it for MCA approval."

Applications for the 1993 MCA Grand National must be received by national headquarters no later than March 1, 1992.

Applications for 1993 MCA National shows must be submitted no later than April 1, 1993.

"We have also found that regional groups are having to book show sites a minimum of a year in advance, so we hope this year's deadlines represent a fair compromise between the previous dates and last year's deadlines," Dillard said.

All applications for MCA-sanctioned Grand National and National shows must be submitted on forms provided by MCA.

Regional groups may obtain those forms by writing to Dillard in care of MCA at P.O. Box 447, Lithonia, GA 30058.

"Of, if you prefer, call the national office at (404) 482-4822 and leave your name and regional group affiliation and I'll be happy to return your call and discuss the procedures," Dillard said.

Annual Grand National shows are awarded by the MCA board of directors one month in advance of National shows. That permits a regional group which might apply for a Grand National to resubmit its application as a National show in the event another group is awarded the Grand National.

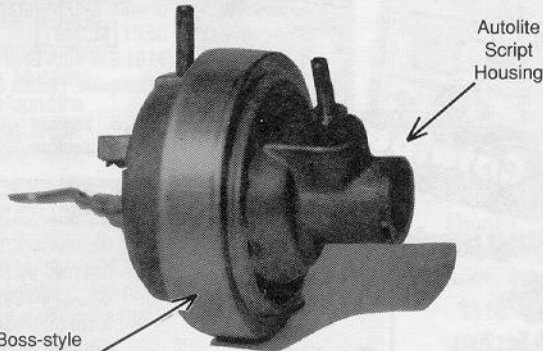
"I've talked to a number of groups in recent months who have expressed interest in hosting MCA events in 1993 and I am pleased with the response. However, the deadlines are rapidly approaching, so it's time to stop talking and start filling out the paperwork," Dillard said.

"We're always interested in holding MCA events in new parts of the country, and, of course, we appreciate those regional groups who apply — on a regular basis — to host a national event."

Dillard said organizing and holding an MCA National or Grand National "certainly involves a lot of work and requires enthusiasm and dedication on the part of the members of the sponsoring regional group. But those groups who have hosted MCA events in the past seem to unanimously agree that the effort is more than worth it."

"The national organization is dedicated to providing all the assistance and advice we can to any regional group interested in applying for and hosting a national show."
