

President's Award Will Honor Regional Groups

This is the time of year when most MCA Regional Groups elect new officers for the coming year, and it is an appropriate time to announce the creation of a new award designed to recognize our regional clubs for the vital role they play in the preservation of the Mustang tradition.

The MCA Board of Directors has voted to create a "President's Award," a special honor which is within the grasp of all our 100-plus regional groups.

Clubs will compete with themselves — not against other regional groups — for this award.

The board has established a group of 17 activities upon which this award will be based. Each group activity carries a specific number of points, and any MCA Regional Group accumulating 100 points in a given calendar year will eligible to receive the President's Award.

As I have said many times in the past, our regional groups are the backbone of MCA. The officers, directors and members of these

These contributions deserve to be recognized, and that's the real purpose behind the President's Award.

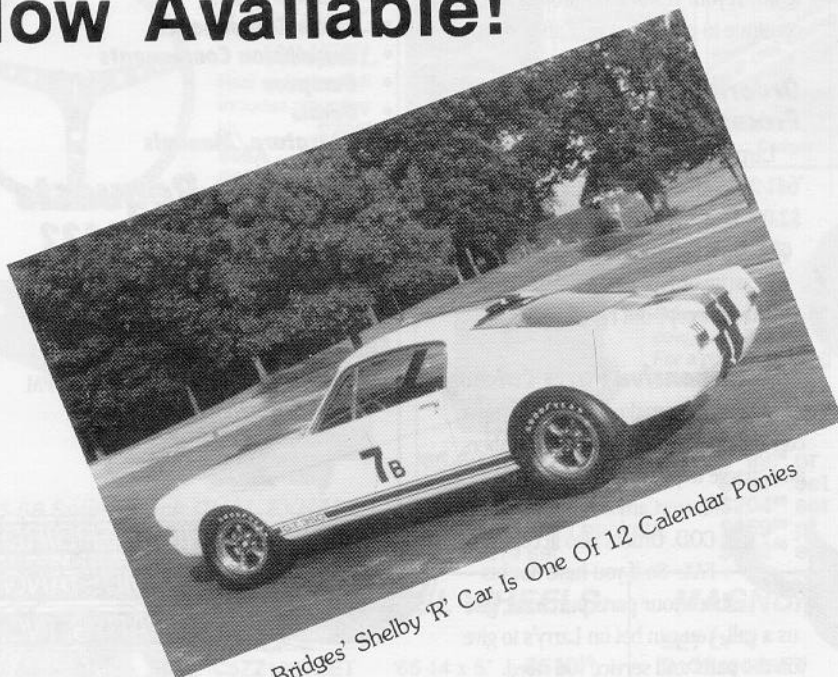
I hope all of our regional groups will get involved in this program and start 1992 with a goal of winning a President's Award for their contributions during the coming year.
