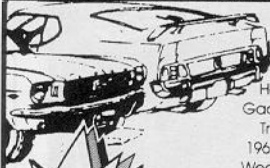

Hampton Re-Elected MCA President

Serving with Coulston will be Teresa Hvidston, vice president; Theresa Miller, secretary; and Peggy Jones, treasurer.

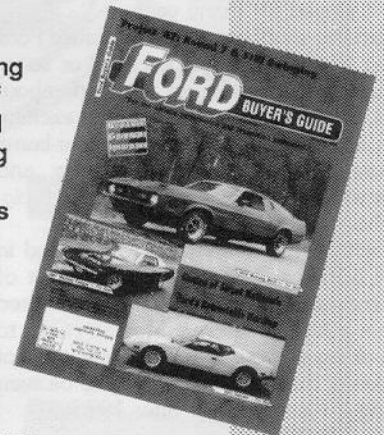
