

Atlanta To Host '92 Grand National

Three Georgia MCA Regional Groups — Northeast Georgia Mustang Club, Cherokee Mustang Club, and Georgia Regional Mustang Club — have been selected to host the 1992 MCA Grand National in suburban Atlanta, GA.

The MCA Board of Directors awarded the 1992 Grand National at its February meeting, held at the Marriott Courtyard Hotel in Marietta, GA.

The application from the three Georgia Regional Groups was one of two receibved by the board for the 1992 Grand National. The Valley Forge Mustang Club of Pennsylvania also submitted an application for the 1992 season finale.

The 1992 Atlanta Grand National will be an indoor show and will be held over Labor Day Weekend at Elko Exhibition Center off I-85 in suburban Gwinnett County.

The facility includes space for more than 250 cars and approximately 100 vendors.

Ample parking is also available and camper and RV hookups will be available on-site. The three Georgia groups also plan to give away two Mustangs in a his and hers charity promotion which will see one couple win matching Ponies.

The series began Thursday, Feb. 7, at 6:30 p.m. on WPBA, Channel 30, Atlanta Public Television. Subsequent segments will be aired the same day of the week at the same time for the following 12 weeks. The program has aired or is scheduled for broadcast in a number of other markets across the nation.
