

1967 Cobra Draws \$370,000 Bid In Miami Beach

A guardsman-blue 1967 AC Cobra 427 owned by Jack Oswald of St. Simons Island, GA drew a bid of \$370,000 at a recent Kruse International auction held at Miami Beach. But despite the bid, Oswald decided to keep the car, which he believes may be the last of the 301 Cobras ever made. More than 5,000 people attended the auction, which also saw a 1966 Ford Mustang GT convertible sell for \$33,500 to a Japanese buyer.
