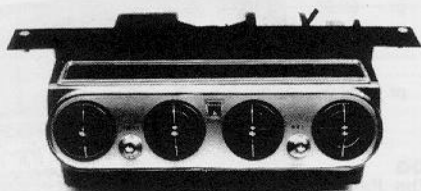
Shorty was also kind enough to work with the staff of *The Mustang Times* to permit us to get some color cover cars photographed in Pensacola.
