Currently serving as president of the Foothills Mustang Club of Greenville, SC, Tommy Gilstrap was elected to the MCA National Board of Directors last year.

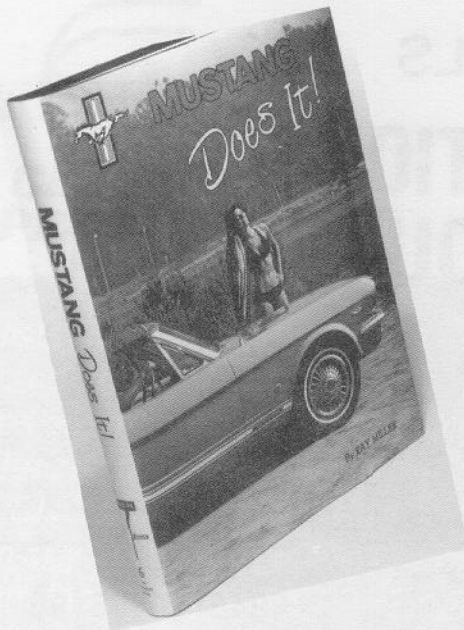
He previously served as vice president of that MCA regional group.
