

MCA 1991 Grand National Is August 16-18

Kingsport, TN will be the site of the final show of the 1991 season — the MCA Grand National.

The Grand National follows the fifth national show of 1991, to be held at John Bleakley Ford in Atlanta July 12-14.

The East Tennessee Regional Group of The Mustang Club of America will serve as host for the Grand National, which will be held outdoors at the Kingsport Civic Center.

Early tech inspection and registration for the Grand National will begin at 8 a.m. Friday, August 16 and members of the sponsoring group urge participants to come early, tech in and get parked for the season-ending event.

Tech inspection will continue all day Friday, closing at 6 p.m.

The East Tennessee Regional Group will sponsor a hospitality party from 6-9 p.m. Friday for those attending the Grand National.

Registration and tech inspection will resume at 7 a.m. Saturday, August 17 and close promptly at 10 a.m.

A judges' meeting will be held Saturday morning prior and judging teams are expected to begin their work by 10 a.m.

A social hour will be held from 6:30-7:30 p.m. Saturday evening and awards will be presented at a 7:30 awards banquet.

Competing cars will remain on display throughout the day Sunday, and a large crowd of spectators is expected.

Show headquarters for the Grand National will be the Kingsport Ramada Inn, 2005 La Masa Drive in Kingsport. The telephone number for the hotel is (615) 245-0271.

Greg Horne, show chairman for the 1991 Grand National, says the East Tennessee Regional Group has worked hard to "make this Grand National enjoyable for all participants.

"The show site is paved, well lit and centrally located. We have access to the auditorium, which will provide facilities for exhibits, meetings, judges' headquarters and restrooms.

"In addition, we are planning shopping opportunities for those who wish to take a break from the show."

Horne says there are also facilities for swimming adjacent to the show site.

The Grand National will be the final of six MCA-sanctioned shows held this year.

Tech inspection for the Atlanta show, sponsored by the Georgia Regional Mustang Club, will begin Friday, July 12, at 4 p.m. The show site is at the John Bleakley Ford dealership on Thornton Road just off I-20 West of Atlanta.

Registration and tech inspection will continue in Atlanta at 7 a.m. Saturday, July 13. Judging will begin at 11 a.m. Saturday.
