

# Grand National Will Close MCA's 1991 Show Calendar

The 1991 MCA Grand National will close out the show season August 16-18 when the First Tennessee Regional Group hosts the finale at the Kingsport Civic Auditorium in Kingsport, TN.

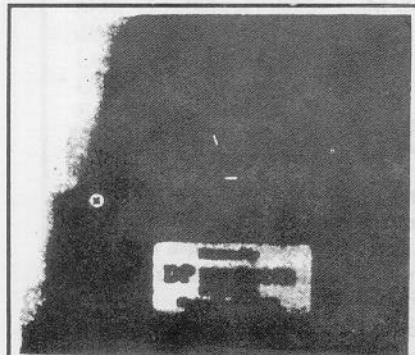
The auditorium is located on Fort Henry Drive. Show headquarters will be the Ramada Inn Kingsport, 2005 La Masa Drive.

Early registration and tech inspection for the 1991 MCA Grand National begins at 8 a.m. Friday, August 16 and will continue until 6 p.m.

The First Tennessee MCA Regional Group will host a welcoming barbeque and reception from 6-9 p.m. Friday.

Registration and tech inspection will continue at 7 a.m. Saturday morning and will close promptly at 10 a.m.

After a judges' meeting, evaluation of the cars will begin and continue until 5 p.m. Saturday.
