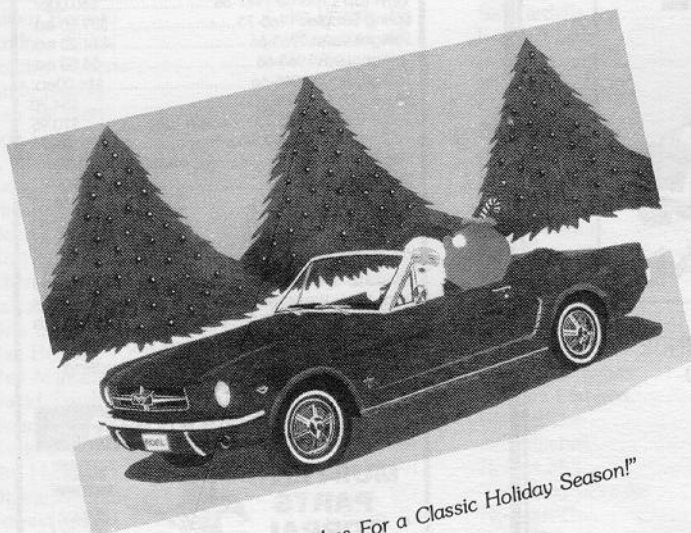
**Cocoa, FL**
