

'92 MCA National Judges Meeting Convenes Nov. 7th

The 1992 National Judges Meeting for the Mustang Club of America will begin at 8 a.m. Saturday, Nov. 7, at the Sheraton Kensington Hotel in Tulsa, OK.

A hospitality session will be held from 8-9 a.m. and the opening general session of the Judges' Meeting will get underway at 9 a.m.

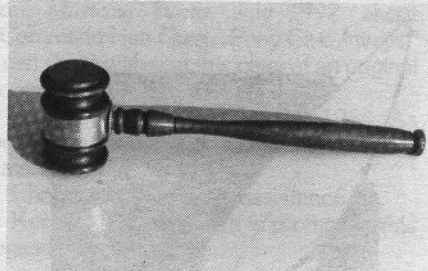
MCA National Head Judge Ricky Simmons and National President Bill Dillard will preside over the session.

The Green Country Classic Mustangs of Tulsa, OK, one of MCA's most active and oldest regional groups, will host the Judges' Meeting.

The purpose of the meeting is to consider rules changes, rules corrections and rules clarifications for the 1993-94 show season.

Official Mustang Club of America judging rules are used at all MCA-sanctioned National and Grand National events. The rules are also used by many regional groups for local Mustang shows.

Changes in the official judging rules are made only once every two years. Judges' meetings held in odd-numbered years are limited to technical corrections and clarifications in existing rules.



Simmons said the group will split into various sub-committees after the opening session to work on rules for various show classes.

"We plan to split into street driven, concours, modified and late model groups. Each of those groups will work on the specific rules for those classes.

"In the afternoon, we will reconvene as one group and discuss the various changes, clarifications, corrections and suggestions that are developed by these individual groups."

The meeting is open to all current MCA members. You do not have to be a certified

or Gold Card Judge to participate in the rules making process or to vote on suggested changes.

Simmons urged all MCA members who can to attend the meeting.

"We need a broad spectrum of opinions and input. MCA's judging rules are among the most specific and precise in the classic car hobby and we want to keep them that way by incorporating new research and new information into our rule book."

Dillard also encouraged participation in the meeting.

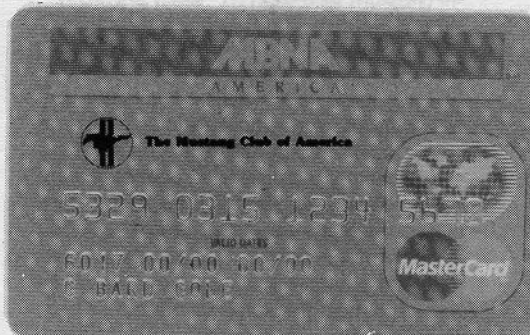
"Anyone who has any suggestions, complaints or comments relating to MCA's judging rules will have the opportunity at this meeting to express those feelings and to have those attending consider any changes you feel are necessary.

"MCA's precise judging rules have been instrumental in preserving the value of the Ford Mustang. We want to continue to clarify and amend our rules so that they provide a comprehensive and authoritative reflection of the Mustang as it came from the factory. Your input into this process will be greatly appreciated," Dillard said.
