MCA Board of Directors October Meeting Minutes

The October meeting of the Board of Directors of the Mustang Club of America was called to order by the Treasurer, Bill Koivu, Tuesday, Oct. 13, 1992.

Roll call was made with 23 directors responding.

Minutes of the September meeting were approved with one change. The name of the Saleen Club was corrected to Saleen Owners & Enthusiasts Club. The September treasurer's report was read and approved.

OLD BUSINESS

The regional group rosters were discussed. A motion was made and approved requiring all Board members to contact their assigned regional groups and discuss any roster information received and request rosters not yet received.

Jim Osborn reported that negotiations have been finalized with Charlotte Motor Speedway and MCA is awaiting a contract. The Speedway will run a two-day open track event during the 30th Anniversary Mustang Convention to be sponsored by MCA. The convention will also include a concours car show, exhibit cars and a swap meet.

Nominations were taken for Show Chairman of this event. A motion was made and approved electing Jim Osborn to that position.

Jim Reynolds of the Tennessee Valley Mustang Club reported on the MCA National Show in Oak Ridge, TN in September. The group had a total of 125 cars, with 87 judged. Of the judged cars, 28 percent were in Street Driven; 21 percent in Street Concours, 15 percent in Trailered Concours, 12 percent in Late Model and five percent in Modified.
