Old Business

Sue Osborn advised that new advertising rate cards and folders have been printed for the *Mustang Times*. The new advertising rates are effective November 1, 1993 for the January issue.

Horace Wood presented the territorial map, with a 34 mile radius, for the *Greater Rochester Mustangs*, the MCA's newest regional group.

Jim Reynolds and Bill Vermillion of the *Tennessee Valley Mustang Club* presented certificates of appreciation to the Board members who helped at the National Show at Oak Ridge. They advised the Board that 125 cars were in attendance and the show was a great success.

30th Anniversary

Jim Osborn, 30th Mustang Anniversary Celebration Show Chairman, advised the Board that Board members and their families are *not* eligible to win any of the door prizes that will be given away at the *Evening With Ford* banquet.
