

Pensacola Show In March Opens 1993 MCA Season

The 14th annual Gulf Coast National Mustang Show, the first MCA-sanctioned national show of 1993, will be held March 26-27 in Pensacola, FL.

The show is the first of six MCA events scheduled for 1993.

Hosted by the Gulf Coast Mustang Club, an MCA regional group, the event will be held at University Mall off I-10 (Exit 5) in Pensacola.

Vendor set up and early tech inspection will begin at 8 a.m. Friday, March 26. The Gulf Coast Regional Group's famous fish fry will be held from 6-11 p.m. Friday evening. The fish fry will be held at Hampton Inn and will include entertainment.

Tech inspection and parking will begin at 7 a.m. Saturday. Registration will close at noon, when judging will begin.

Trophies will be presented at a 7:30 p.m. ceremony Saturday evening.

Vendors must register by March 15.

The club's prize car is a 1969 Mustang convertible. Proceeds from the prize car will benefit Ronald McDonald House, Hadji Shrine Transportation Fund for Burned and Crippled Children, and Sacred Heart Children's Hospital.

All show vehicles must remain in place until 5 p.m. Saturday.
