NEW BUSINESS

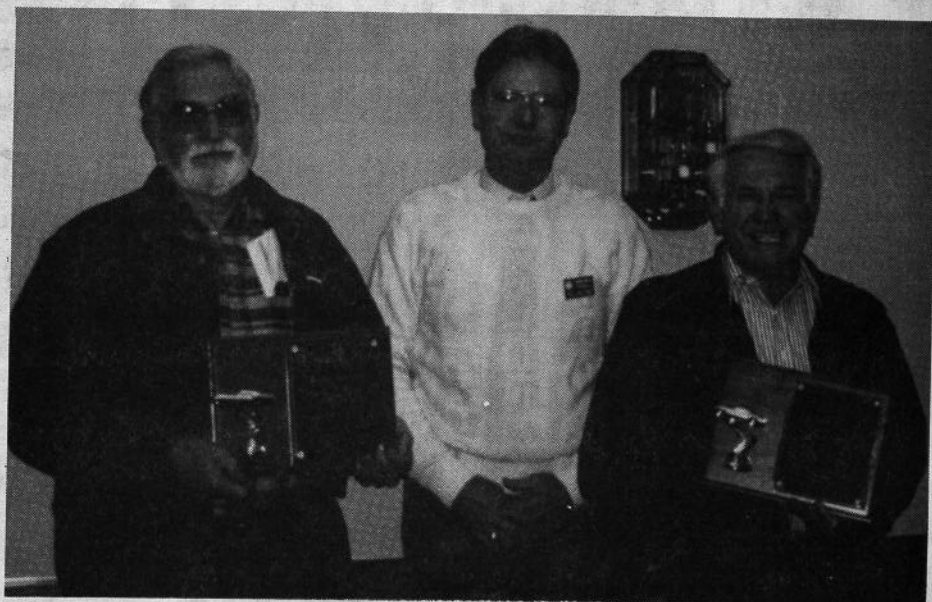
Several letters were discussed. Bill Dillard and Kitty Wilmot agreed to respond to those as needed.
