A Tip For Engine Detailing

Here's a trick to use while detailing your engine.

When painting your engine block and heads, it is difficult to clean and paint around the spark plugs.

If you leave the spark plugs in, you can't do a really good job of cleaning and painting in those recesses.

If you take the spark plugs out to clean and paint, you risk getting dirt and paint in your engine's cylinders.

To solve this problem, remove the spark plugs and put a solid No. 1 rubber stopper in the holes. A 1-1/2" drywall screw can be used to remove the stopper.
