

# 30th Anniversary Committee Adopts Official Logo

The committee responsible for planning the Mustang Club of America's 30th Mustang Anniversary Convention for 1994 has adopted its official logo, which will be used in promotional material and on memorabilia associated with the birthday celebration scheduled for Charlotte, NC.

Jim Osborn, chairman of the committee, said the logo will be used on registration forms, correspondence, and in conjunction with publicity and advertising for the April 15-17, 1994 event.

Osborn also announced that the committee has established a telephone hot-line and post office box and has added a new member.

"Anyone interested in information regarding the show can call (404) 482-9634," Osborn said.

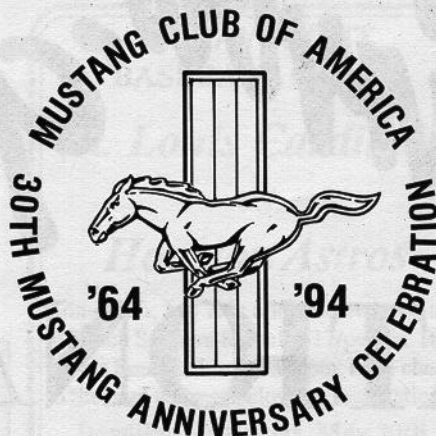
The new post office box address for the 30th Mustang Anniversary Convention is P.O. Box 870527, Stone Mountain, GA 30087.

Osborn said anyone interested in being placed on a list to receive a show flyer and registration form should send a stamped, self-addressed envelope to that post office box address.

"We anticipate having a registration form and show flyer available by the first of May," he added.

The show chairman said the unexpectedly high level of interest in the 30th Anniversary Convention indicates that the event will be an early sell-out.

"I want to stress that the number of cars we can accommodate at Charlotte is limited and once registration forms are available, we expect those spaces to go fast. If you don't want to miss having your car in this event, I suggest you send in your request for a registration form today. We expect to fill all available slots at least six to seven months in advance of the April, 1994 show."



Osborn also announced that MCA National Secretary Kitty Wilmot has joined the 30th Anniversary Convention Committee. Mrs. Wilmot will serve as secretary to

the committee. She is also a member of the MCA Board of Directors and Assistant Editor of *The Mustang Times*.

Negotiations with potential sponsors for the convention are continuing, Osborn said. "We think we are getting very close to some major announcements regarding sponsorship of this event."

The 30th Anniversary Convention is expected to be the largest Mustang event in the history of the world's first Pony Car. In addition to competition in numerous classes, Mustang enthusiasts who do not wish to show their cars in the event can attend as spectators.

In addition to a car show, vendors, product demonstrations, and family activities, an open track event is planned in conjunction with the convention.

Osborn said a list of hotel accommodations and rates will appear in the May issue of *The Mustang Times*.
