

Little Rock To Host Second MCA Show Of '93

Little Rock, AR — former home of First Mustanger Bill Clinton — will be the site of the second MCA-sanctioned National Show of the 1993 season May 21-22.

The current show season opened March 26 in Pensacola, FL, where the Gulf Coast Regional Group hosted the first MCA National of '93. The Pensacola show was the first of six MCA national events scheduled for this year.

Billed as the "River City National," the Little Rock event will be held at the Riverfront Hilton Hotel, 2 Riverfront Place at the Broadway Exit West off I-30.

The national show is being hosted by the Central Arkansas Mustangers, the Northwest Arkansas Mustangers, and the Arkansas Valley Mustang Club.

Early registration (before May 1) is \$25. Registration after May 1 is \$30. (MCA members deduct \$10 from either price).

The show will open with a hospitality party Friday night, May 21, at the Riverfront Hilton.

Early registration and tech inspection will also be available Friday and is encouraged.

Registration and tech inspection will resume at 7 a.m. Saturday, with judging expected to begin at noon. MCA's 1993-94 Official Judging Rules will apply. Any MCA certified or Gold Card Judges attending the show are asked to check in at the registration tent upon arrival and volunteer to assist with judging.

Hotel reservations are available by calling (501) 371-9000. Mention the Mustang show for a special rate of \$48 plus tax.

Awards will be presented Saturday night at a banquet. Banquet tickets are \$15 and must be ordered in advance.

The scene will shift to Cincinnati, OH June 12-13 when the Tri-State Mustang Club hosts an MCA National.

The Cincinnati event will be held at forest Fair Mall and will include a Saleen Owners Central Regional Meet and an SVO Owners Association Mini-Meet.

Registration and tech inspection will begin at 9 a.m. Friday and continue Saturday morning at 8. A hospitality party will be held at the host hotel, AmeriSuites, at 6:30 p.m. Friday.

Registration will close at noon Saturday and judging will begin. Judging will continue Sunday. The show will close with a 2 p.m. awards ceremony Sunday.

Members of the Tri-State Mustang Club request that cars that will be involved in the Mall Car Show arrive on Thursday for early tech inspection, which will be conducted all day Thursday. Cars involved in the mall show will be parked a day earlier than other show cars, the club says.

The Shiloh Valley Mustang Club will sponsor the third National of 1993 in Fairview Heights, IL in suburban St. Louis.

The event will be held at Longacre Park, which offers a wide variety of recreational activities in addition to the Mustang show and swap meet. Park facilities include walking paths, volleyball courts, softball diamonds, tennis courts, a playground, horseshoes and picnic pavilions. Show sponsors urge Mustangers attending to bring their sporting equipment and take advantage of the park's facilities.

An added attraction at the Fairview '93 National is a Friday night baseball game between the St. Louis Cardinals and the Houston Astros. A limited number of tickets — which include game admission and transportation to and from the stadium — are available. Deadline for baseball game tickets is May 30. Those interested in attending the game should contact Steve Packman at (618) 533-5377.

Transportation will also be provided throughout the day between Longacre Park and area motels, shopping malls and restaurants. Overnight security will be provided at the show site Friday.

Early tech inspection for the show will begin Friday and will resume at 7 a.m. Saturday. Judging for 1964½-93 Mustangs will begin at noon Saturday.

An awards banquet will close the show Saturday evening.
