**Minutes Of The February
Board Of Directors Meeting**

The meeting of the Board of Directors of the Mustang Club of America was called to order by the President, Bill Dillard, on Tuesday, February 9, 1992.

Roll call was made with 25 directors responding.

Minutes of the December meeting were read and approved. The December and January treasurer's reports were read and approved. Bob Deale also presented the finance report for the 30th Anniversary show.

OLD BUSINESS

Jim Osborn reported on the 30th Anniversary convention. The negotiations with Ford are progressing well. The main hotel will be the Hilton but the committee has also secured reduced rates with several other hotels in the area.

Regional group rosters were discussed. We had nine groups that did not submit their rosters. Horace Wood reported that the North Jersey Group may be reorganizing and we should hear from them in the near future. A motion was made and approved to rescind the charters on the other 8 groups that did not respond to roster requests. Certified letters will be sent to those eight groups.

Sue Osborn, Publishing Committee head, reported they have spoken with the printer regarding the quality of the magazine. Jim Osborn suggested we try using a higher quality paper for one month. A motion was made and approved to try different paper for one month.

A board replacement was required for Jack Yeager's term, which was not filled in December when he resigned. Also, a motion was made and approved to replace Jim Watson on the Board (with Jim remaining as Vice President) since he is unable to attend due to his relocation.

Nominations were taken and Andy Richardson from Jonesboro, GA and Deryck Hickox from Toronto, Ontario, Canada were elected to serve the remainder of these terms which expire January 31, 1994.

Bill Koivu reported that since he has received several complaints regarding Hertz Car Rental's high rates we will have rental programs available for our members from both Hertz and Alamo Car Rental.

NEW BUSINESS

Ricky Simmons presented reproduction parts for approval as follows:

- ✓ 1965-66 trunk mat from Auto Custom Carpet in Anniston, AL, approved for use on 1965 models ONLY;
- ✓ 1967-73 parking brake cables from AMK Products in Broken Arrow, OK, approved.

Bruce Guiney, secretary of the Georgia Association of Motor Clubs, advised that a bill has been introduced in the Georgia House of Representatives which would hold the tax base on vehicles over 25 years old to a value of \$100. This would keep the ad valorem taxes

An MCA member requested we check in to the possibility of the U.S. Postal Service making a Mustang stamp in honor of next year's 30th anniversary. Darren Parton, a Post Office employee, will find out the procedure and report back.

Horace Wood submitted a regional group application from Pierce County Mustang Club in Tacoma, WA. This club and its territory, which is Pierce County, were approved.

Deryck Hickox reported that in order to assure timely arrival to Canadian members, the magazine should be wrapped in a plastic bag before mailing. Deryck offered to pay the cost of having the Canadian members' magazines wrapped, \$20 per month, until the present Canadian membership doubles.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

The next meeting of the Board of Directors will be Tuesday, April 13, 1993, 7:30 PM, at the Marriott Courtyard, Windy Hill Road, in Marietta, GA.
