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Minutes Of The June Board Of Directors Meet

The meeting of the Board of Directors of the Mustang Club of America was called to order by the President, Bill Dillard, on Tuesday, June 8, 1993. Roll call was made with 20 directors responding.

Minutes of the May meeting were read and approved.

The May treasurer's report was read and approved.

Bob Deale presented the finance report for the 30th Anniversary Celebration.

Guests included Jack Swain, Mid-Florida Mustang Club; Bill Vermillion and J.C. Moneymaker, Tennessee Valley Mustang Club; Mike Jeter, Bruce and Joy Guiney and Barbara Hollingsworth, Northeast Georgia Mustang Club; Charlie Ping, Model City Mustang Club; Norman and Faye Lawrence, Georgia Regional Mustang Club and Joel and Tina Rawlins, Douglas, GA.

OLD BUSINESS

Bruce Weiss advised that he is still negotiating sponsorships for the 30th Anniversary Celebration with the major Mustang magazine publishers. Teresa Vickery advised that over 300 registrations have been received to date. She also has about 500 requests for forms, which should be printed by the end of this month.

Bill Dillard advised that he is receiving an average of three calls per day from Ford Motor Company representatives in Dearborn, MI.

Horace Wood reported that he sent a letter to the North Jersey Mustang Club requesting the return of the club's charter due to a continued failure to comply with MCA By-Laws. To date, he has received no response.

Teresa Vickery advised that she has talked with their representative and was told they are reorganizing again. After much discussion, a motion was made and approved revoking the charter due to this group's continued refusal over the past several years to comply with MCA By-Laws.

Bill Koivu talked with the printer and the price quoted on 60 pound paper at last month's meeting was incorrect. The printer has now obtained a mid-quality paper which will be used in the July issue of *Mustang Times*.

Bruce Guiney presented the new bill recently passed by the Georgia Legislature and signed into law by Gov. Zell Miller. The bill will hold the value of "antique" automobiles to \$100.00 for purposes of ad valorem taxation. Antique automobiles are defined as vehicles over 25 years old.

Ricky Simmons commended the Arkansas Valley, Central Arkansas and NW Arkansas Mustang Clubs for the fine show they hosted in Little Rock last month. They had 183 cars with 168 in judged classes.

To date, rosters have been received from 61 groups. It was decided that any group that has not submitted its roster by the July meeting date will have its charter rescinded.

NEW BUSINESS

Bruce Weiss discussed the new Florida group, Imperial Mustang Club of Polk County. He advised that the other three MCA groups in that area have negotiated territory rights with the new club and all territories have been agreed upon. Horace advised that he has written territory agreements from Mid-Florida Mustang Club and Space Coast Mustang Club and a verbal agreement from Suncoast Mustang Club. A motion was made and approved to accept Imperial
