## September Board Meeting Minutes

### Old Business

Jim Osborn, 30th Anniversary Proceeds Committee, advised Ford is very interested in helping us with office space, however, they are currently negotiating with their landlord which may take some time.

Bob Vickery, Publishing Committee, advised they have written job duties for the editor; are getting quotes on printing the magazine; are still discussing the paper quality and do not yet have a new publisher. They will ask the editor to attend the Judges Meeting in November.

A thank you card was received from the First Tennessee Regional Group thanking the MCA officers and Board members that helped with the National show in Kingsport.

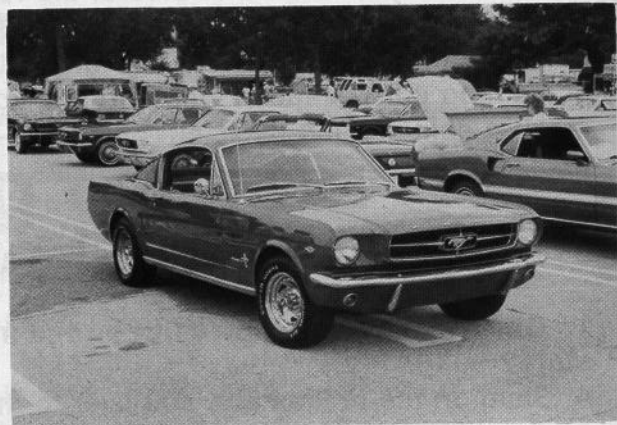
It was reported that a commercial Mustang magazine has offered to print The Mustang Times and insert it into the center of their monthly publication. A motion was made and approved declining their offer.

Larry Kilgore, Carolina Regional Mustang Club, advised his group is planning to submit an application for a National show in 1996.

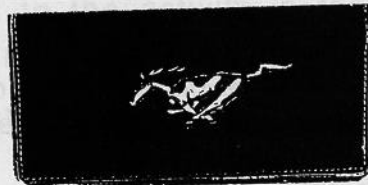
