Board Votes To Increase Membership Dues Effective April 1, 1994 Based On Publishing Committee Findings

The meeting was called to order by the President, Bill Dillard, on Tuesday, December 14, 1993. Roll call was made with 24 directors responding,

Minutes of the November Board meeting were read and approved. The November treasurer's report was read and approved. Bob Deale presented the financial report for the 30th Mustang Anniversary Celebration.

Guests included J.C. Moneymaker, *Tennessee Valley Mustang Club*; Dale Mathis, *Cherokee Regional Mustang Club*; Robb Conquest and Steve Kiker, *Georgia Regional Mustang Club*; Gary Fontaine, *Heart of Dixie Mustang Club*; Irvin Clack, *Mid-Mississippi Mustang Club*; Charlie and Bob Ping, *Model City Mustang Club*; Al Dulaney, *Heart of Carolina Mustang Club*; Bob Augustine and Ken Potter, *SVO Owners Association, Georgia Chapter*; Chris Hoverman, *Mustangs Unlimited, Manchester, CT*; and Bob Bigelow, Alpharetta, GA.

Old Business

Bill Dillard reported that Ford Motor Company is trying to develop a program wherein they will be a clearinghouse for information on all year models. Dillard has invited Ford to attend a Board meeting to explain this idea to the MCA.

Bill Koivu advised that the Installation Dinner and Annual Meeting will be held Saturday, January 15, 1994 at The Mansion in downtown Atlanta. Reservation information is in the January 1994 *Mustang Times*.

Jim Osborn advised that there will be no car or vendor registrations permitted at the Charlotte Motor Speedway. All car show participants and vendors must pre-register. Based on current registrations,

the projected sell-out date is March 15, 1994. Osborn also read a letter from the **Classic Mustang Club of Sweden**. Several of the club's members will be attending the 30th Mustang Anniversary Celebration and would like to present some awards of their own. They also want to give away one airline ticket to Sweden in order for the winner to attend their 30th Mustang Anniversary show.

Ricky Simmons advised that there will be a 30th Mustang Anniversary Judges' meeting on Saturday, January 15, 1994 at 9 a.m. at the Marriott at Gwinnett Place in Duluth, GA.

Sue Osborn gave a Publishing Committee report. The Publishing Committee recommended that MCA membership dues be increased beginning April 1, 1994. The increases are \$30 per year for US members, \$40 for Canadian, and \$65 for foreign. Dues have not been increased for eight years and may have to be reviewed again in 15-18 months. A motion was made and approved accepting their recommendations as presented.

Jim Watson reviewed letters from Ford Motor Company and the **Mustang Club of Indianapolis** requesting the MCA's approval of their show planned for April 15-17, 1994 at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. The motion was made to approve their show and advise them of the ad rates and deadlines for the **Mustang Times**.

Charlie Hampton discussed the fact that all Board members will be needed and expected to work at the 30th Mustang Anniversary Celebration. He stressed that Board members need to be communicating with their respective regional groups and attending as many National shows as possible.

New Business

Due to the 30th Mustang Anniversary show date, a motion was made and approved to change the date of the April Board meeting to April 5, 1994.

Sue Osborn resigned as Publisher. And Jim Osborn resigned from the Publishing Committee. A motion was made and approved accepting their resignations. Jerry Gilbert and Andy Richardson volunteered to join the Publishing Committee. The committee will choose the new publisher.

Jim Watson advised that he has received two requests for show applications for 1995 and expects several more. Grand National applications are due March 1, 1994. National applications are due by April 1, 1994.

Horace Wood presented a Regional Group application from the **Southwest Florida Mustang Club** in Naples, Florida. A motion was made and

approved accepting their application and territory as presented.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

The next meeting of the MCA Board of Directors will be Tuesday, February 8, 1994 at the Marriott Courtyard, Windy Hill Road, in Marietta, GA. **MT**
