Cypress Gardens May Host Year End MCA National Show

The MCA Board meeting was called to order by President Bill Dillard on Tuesday, May 10, 1994. Roll call was made with 28 directors responding.

The April minutes were read and approved, as were the April and May treasurer's reports.

Guests included Tim Holland, *NE Georgia Mustang Club*; Tony and Linda Garcia, *Georgia Regional Mustang Club*; Kenny and Marilyn Newcombe, *Tara Mustang Club*; Bob Ping, *Model City Mustang Club*; Joel Rawlins, Douglas, GA; Dick Mackal, Acworth, GA; and Bob Featherstone, Bob Dorman, and Reuben Best of *Emerald House Publishing* of Fort Walton Beach, FL.

OLD BUSINESS

Jim Watson presented a 30th Mustang Anniversary Celebration award clock to Jim and Sue Osborn on behalf of the MCA Board of Directors. Bruce Weiss also delivered to Jim Osborn the ring the ring that the 30th Anniversary Committee had made in thanks for his hard work and dedication to the MCA and the 30th Mustang Anniversary Celebration.

Jim Osborn presented the MCA with original 30th Mustang Anniversary items for the MCA archives. He advised that the final car count was in excess of 3000 cars.

Jerry Gilbert, Publisher, advised that the publishing committee will be meeting in the next few days to discuss possible changes regarding the magazine.

Jim Watson advised that the *Space Coast Mustang Club* is having some internal problems and may vote not to host the final MCA National Show this year. He advised that the promoters of the Cypress Gardens Mustang Show have offered to change that event to an MCA National Show instead. This show is hosted by three MCA Regional Groups, *Suncoast Mustang Club*, *Mid-Florida Mustang Club*, and *Classic Mustangs of Tampa*. After some discussion, a motion was made and approved to request a show application on this change and discuss it at the next Board meeting.

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Jim Watson also advised that the **Mustang Club of Houston** has requested a change of date for their 1995 National Show. The new dates are June 30 - July 2, 1995. A motion was made and passed approving this date change.

Several MCA Regional shows were discussed and requests made for Board members to attend as many as possible.

Bob Simmons resigned from the Board of Directors due to his inability to attend Board meetings. He included several suggestions regarding MCA procedures and By-Laws. Based on those suggestions, a motion was made and approved to appoint a committee of five to discuss these ideas and possible By-Laws changes that would need to be made. The committee includes Jim Watson, Andy Richardson, Cliff Watson, Charlie Hampton, and Bruce Weiss.

NEW BUSINESS

Bill Dillard advised that another claim has been submitted for damages done to a car at the show in Indianapolis back in April.

Evergreen Press requested a free ad in exchange for a membership promotion. After some discussion, a motion was made and approved to decline their request.

Bruce Weiss advised that **Classic Mustangs of Tampa** has requested that an MCA officer attend a meeting between their group and the **Suncoast Mustang Club** to discuss their territorial dispute. A motion was made and approved to send Jim Watson. Jim will coordinate the trip to meet with the two Regional Groups.

Ricky Simmons submitted the following parts for approval - Front and rear Autolite replacement shocks from Black Jack Reproductions, Carroll, OH. Because these parts were not correct, they were not approved. A 1969-70 antenna base from Metro Obsolete of Douglas, GA was approved by the Board.

Nominations to replace Bob Simmons on the Board may be submitted prior to the next Board meeting.

Bill Koivu presented a leather coat from Perrone Leather of Gloversville, NY. They requested we add this coat to our MCA accessories. In return, the MCA receives a 15-percent commission. A motion was made and passed approving this request.

Jim Osborn presented Press Passes that were made for **Mustang Times** editors.

With there being no further business, the Board meeting was adjourned.


