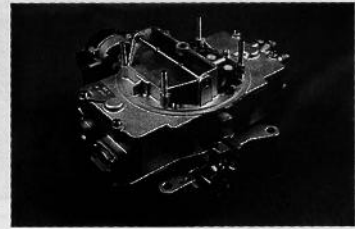

Jim Reynolds inquired about business cards for Board Members. This was tabled until next month when we should have more information regarding office space.

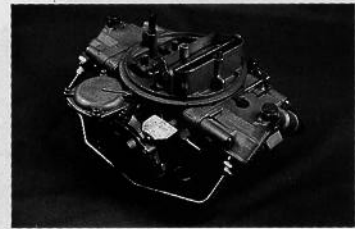
