## Board Meeting Notice by Lynn Perry

The meeting was called to order by the President, Jim Osborn on June 13, 1995. Roll call was made with 30 directors responding.

Each committee head reported attendance for May meetings as follows: Accessory - 100%; Judging - 100%; Publishing - 100%; National Show - 100%; Advertising - No Meeting; Administrative - 100%; Regional Group - No Meeting; Special Events - 2 meetings - 100%.

Guests recognized: Lynn Watson, Paula Watson & Chuck Smith - Heart of Georgia; Gordon Land & Faye Lawrence - Georgia Regional; Jason Sloan - Cherokee Regional. Gloria Richardson & Debbie Gunnin - Tara Regional; Barbara Hollingsworth - NE Georgia; Tami Johnson - MCA; and Rory Bruton, RDB Marketing.

National Directors from Regional Groups included: Bruce Guiney - NE Georgia and Jonathon Parker - Cherokee Regional.

The April Minutes were amended to include J.C. Moneymaker as Tennessee Valley Regional Group National Director in attendance. Minutes approved.

The Treasurer's Report was read and approved through May 31, 1995.

### Old Business

Accessory Committee Report - Butch Hollingsworth reported the committee has approved and is working out details to include a hat pin for accessory sales.

Advertising Committee Report - Bill Koivu and his committee have placed several classified ads for sample magazines, each to run 3-6 months. Results to follow.

Judging Committee Report - Ricky Simmons reports that the judging sheets are complete. The committee is in process to provide judging sheets for each model year. Report to follow.

Administrative Committee Report - Kenny Newcombe discussed computer specifications and requested information from each committee chairperson. The committee has looked at the existing program and system and is compiling additional information to make a decision on the purchase.

Regional Group Committee Report - Rochelle McNeal submitted approval for a new chartered group, which has met the requirements. Motion was made and approved to award the Badgerland Mustang Club of Madison, Wisconsin their charter.

Publishing Committee Report - Bob Vickery reported that Sewell Printing has prepared a budget and will submit at the Executive Board Meeting.

National Show Committee Report - Jim Watson will re-submit budget amount for his committee at the next meeting. The brochure is in process for application and requirements for National and Grand National MCA approved shows.

Special Events Committee Report - Several contracts are approved and signed for the 20th Anniversary Celebration. The registration fees and accessory fees have been set. The advertising flyer should be available within about two weeks. Also, three Chairpersons have been added to the 20th Anniversary Celebration Staff, as follows: Bruce Weiss, Promotions; Chuck Smith, Special Events; and John Moats, Security.

Museum Report - Bill Dillard announced the next meeting will be at the Atlanta Motor Speedway on July 7, 1995. Agenda: Direction of the Project.

Other - Andy Richardson reported due to lightening damage, repairs to get the Bulletin Board back on line estimate at \$250. Motion approved for repairs. Roger Johnson will include an article in the Mustang Times to inform all MCA members about the Bulletin Board.

## New Business

A letter was read from Jean Penn (#21237) requesting a charitable donation to help the citizens of Oklahoma with the disaster relief. After much discussion of two different charities in need, a motion was made and approved to award \$5,000 to the Governor Frank Keatings Victim & Family Relief Fund, Office of the Governor, State Capital, Oklahoma City, OK 73105. The Executive Board shall set standards for future charitable contributions at the next meeting.

The Nominating Committee for the next election of the Board of Directors shall be headed by Charlie Hampton, with Randy Church, Gary Fountaine, Butch Hollingsworth, and Jim Johnson assisting.

Due to the opening on the Board of Directors, John Hayden was elected to fill the vacancy. His term will expire January of 1997.

Butch Hollingsworth volunteered to head the Committee to publish a 1996 MCA Calendar. The Committee also includes Kitty Wilmot and Gloria Richardson.

Bruce Guiney reported the M24 Pollution Standards are temporarily dead in the water. Recommendations and testing of the GT40 is in the process. 1973 to current will be tested. Updates shall be reported in future meetings.

Jim Osborn presented letter of 1/5/95 from the Southeastern Michigan Mustang Club requesting reinstatement of their charter. The charter was pulled due to MCA requirement to submit officers and roster lists each year. Enclosed with this letter was compliance information. After discussion, the Board approved and reinstated the Club charter, with apologies for delay in response time.

With there being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
