Max was presented a plaque by Don Wolfe on behalf of the membership for a job well done.



Our banquet was attended by about 75 people. The variety and quality of food was excellent. The evening was finalized with members, families and guests participating in bingo amid much shop talk.


Our next regular meeting will be 7:00 p.m. January 26th at Anderson Ford.


