The interior is red and black and has Mach I bucket seats. The car is equipped with a custom tape player and 4 speakers. The car is equipped with a C-4 automatic transmission, power steering, power brakes and outside remote control mirror.

Under the hood is a 351 Windsor 4-V, all stock engine. I also have a 1967 Mustang fastback with a 289 engine with 302 heads and 12-1 pistons, 2-V carb.
