1968 MUSTANG CONVERTIBLE

I purchased my 1968 blue Mustang convertible from an acquaintance for \$900 in the spring of 1976. The car had 84,135 miles and had the following features:

302-4V, 4 speed transmission, power steering, power front disc brakes, power top, limited slip differential, console, tachometer, AM radio, courtesy lights, woodgrain trim, GT package, tinted windows and accent stripe.

When purchased, the car had a bent rear bumper, a damaged right front fender, needed a new convertible top and paint. All other items were in very good to excellent condition.

As of this time, I have replaced the convertible top, the right front fender and the rear bumper. The car has been completely re-painted and has gone through a general clean-up.

My plans for the immediate future is a complete detailing of the engine compartment and the undercarriage. This is a "driven Mustang" as this is my second Mustang convertible...my first now belongs to my father.

These cars have given me many hours of enjoyment and some attention from auto admirers as we drive them. I am also in the process of restoring two "Boss 302" Mustangs (1970) models.
