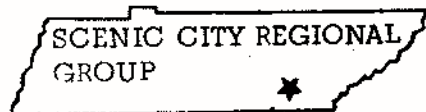


MUSTANG OWNERS' CLUB OF SOUTHEASTERN MICHIGAN
