Register your cars early and meet us in Atlanta for the Greatest Mustang Show Ever!

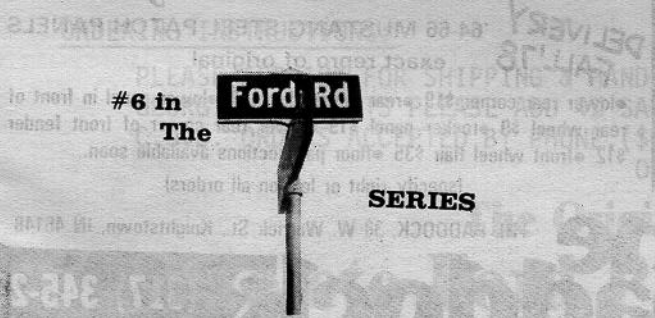
