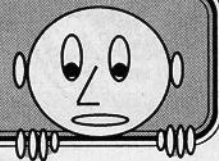

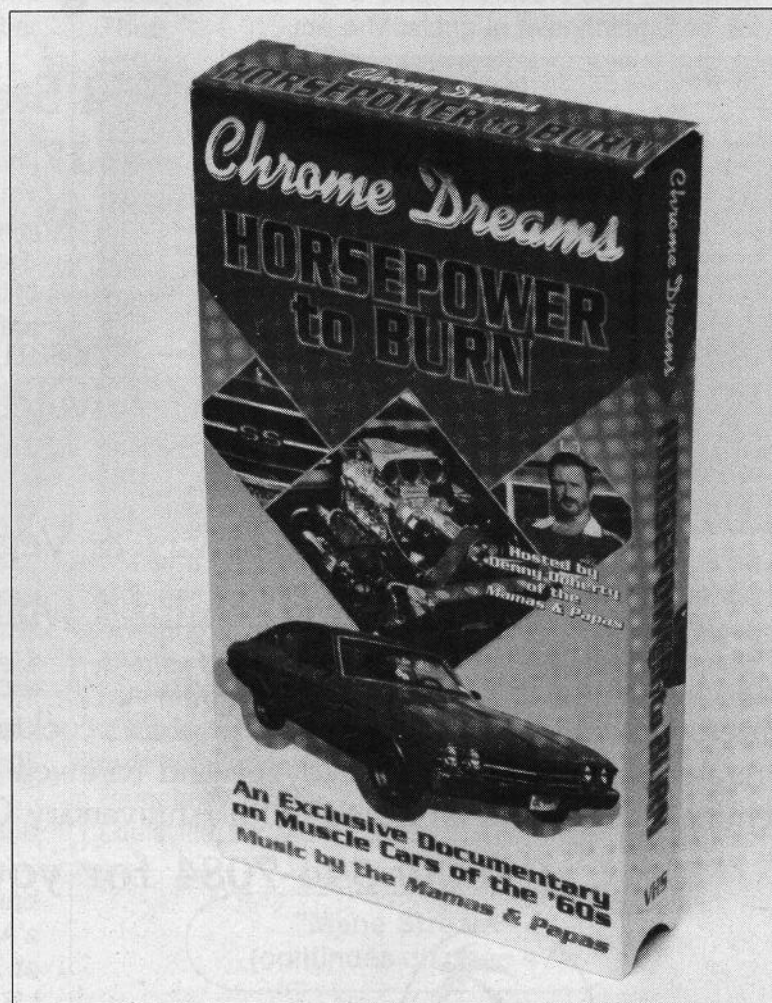

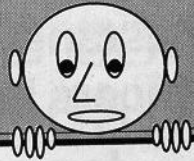
"Horsepower To Burn"

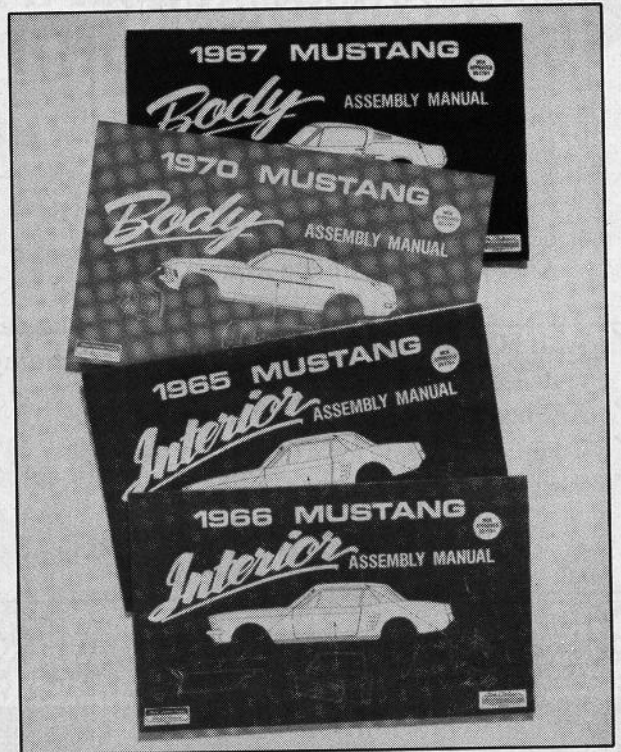
