A search began for the ultimate upgrades which culminated in the Stage 2 Roush package. Amenities of the **Medium Graphite leather interior** include the Mach 460 sound system replete with CD player, and rear window defroster.



Gene Masters of **Montgomery, Illinois**, is the third owner of this **1984 V6 convertible**. The **Bright Canyon Red** pony is all original with the exception of a custom exhaust system. Options include **Premium Sound, light/convenience group, and Styled Steel wheels with trim rings**. Gene has owned the ragtop for over four years and uses it as a "fair weather" car. He stated, "It's no stranger to parades, having hauled homecoming queens, baseball players, even Santa Claus and Uncle Sam on its (white) boot over the folded top."

Robert Gunderson of **Elk River, Minnesota**, found this **1964 1/2 convertible** residing in a shed with tires, iron, and other junk piled on top. Equipped with a **D-code 289 and power top**, and with a build date of July 23, 1964, Robert knew this project was well worth the undertaking.
