Minutes for the November meeting were discussed and approved.

Treasurer's report was passed out, but no discussion due to absence of the treasurer.

### Committee Reports

**Judging Committee** - A motion was made and approved to purchase a fax machine for the national head judge position due to timely communications.

A motion was made and approved to sell advertising space/sponsorship space in the next printed judging rules books. This space is open to all vendors who have approved MCA parts.

A motion was made and approved to begin a Gold Card and Certified Judging Contest.
