We have received a few requests for corrections on the Mid-Atlantic National Mustang Show winners list:

Division IV - Street Driven (Occasional Driven) 1964 1/2 - 66 Coupe, 2nd place awards were presented to Charles Dowd and Ron & Cindy Movinski. These folks were inadvertently omitted from the list. (Rumor has it that this omission occurred while the editor was daydreaming of winning an award with one of her Mustangs.)

Division VI - Modified, 1964 1/2 - 73 Street Driven Excluding Undercarriage, 1st place awarded to Michael Bazan. Also in this division, 1974-95 Street Driven Excluding Undercarriage, Andera Franklin should be listed as a 2nd place recipient.

Division I - Concours Trailered, 1966 Open Gold, Mike and Gloria Bazan were listed as Mike and Gloria Brown.

And While We're On The Subject

The information which appears on National show registration forms passes through several pairs of hands before landing on the editor's desk. We therefore make the following request to help make sure the information remains accurate during the various stages of a show: please either type or neatly print your name and address on the registration forms. Oft times we are in a hurry to get a car entered in a show and perhaps have waited until the deadline is looming over us to take

the necessary steps. But please take time to make sure all the information is legible.

When you arrive at the registration area of a show you might also wish to check with registration personnel to make sure your name is spelled correctly in the records they have before them. This will help us all in the long run.

In order to receive your judging sheets from an MCA National or Grand National event please send self-addressed, stamped envelopes as follows:

For entries in Concours, Second Generation (1974-78), Third Generation (1979-93) and Saleen classes, send a self-addressed, business-sized envelope with 78¢ postage.

For entries in Street Driven, Daily Driven and Modified classes, send a self-addressed, business-sized envelope with 32¢ postage.

All requests should indicate the name of the show as well as the location. It is extremely important that you supply your car entry number from the show so hang on to those dash cards. Send your request to:

Speaker Installation Follow-up

On page 27 of our June issue (Replacing your Pony's Stock Stereo), we indicated removing the speaker grill from the door panel to access the factory speaker hole in the Fox-bodied cars. It is also accessible by removing the entire door panel.

Some may find this a safer option, although it is more work and there is never any guarantee of a proper fit. The key is to take your time and use good judgement and patience during the procedure.
