By now you have heard of this book and know there is no other book like it.

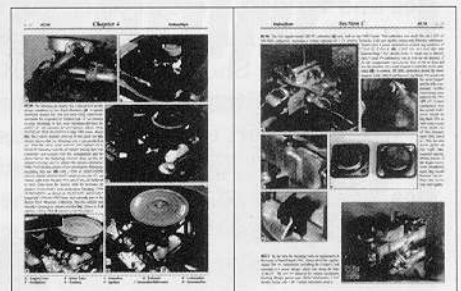
