North Texas Mustang Club Hosts 9th Annual Yellow Rose Show

Over 200 cars and trucks, along with numerous vendors and several Ford dealers, took part in the 9th Annual Yellow Rose All Ford Show hosted by North Texas Mustang Club, August 15-16, in Fort Worth, Texas. As Texas weather goes, it was warm, well you could say hot, with 100+ temperatures outside. However, everyone seemed to enjoy the show in the air conditioned comfort of the exhibit hall of the Will Rogers Memorial Center.

Events started Thursday evening with members marking off and numbering spaces in preparation of the move-in. Move-in started early Friday with time out for pizza at 6 p.m. By 10 p.m., most of the vehicles and vendors were in place. All had to be in place by 9 a.m. Saturday morning for the 10 a.m. opening to the public. Show hours were 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Saturday and 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday.
