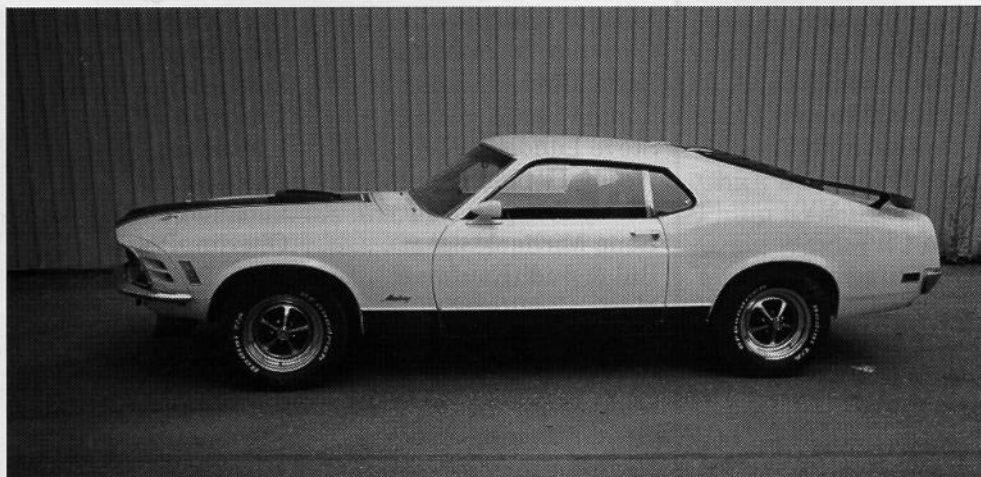

He indicates that the Mach 1 was a "rustoration" that was completed just last year. Packed with plenty of goodies, this **yellow** attention-getter sports **front and rear spoilers, rear window louvers, Magnum 500 wheels, Shaker hood, and a 351 Cleveland engine** coupled with a **C-6 automatic transmission**. The Pace Car has been updated with a **four-barrel induction system, modified cylinder heads, exhaust headers and dual pipes, T-5 transmission and rear axle quad shocks**. Ian refurbished the pony last winter after 14 years of ownership and 100,000 miles of driving pleasure.
