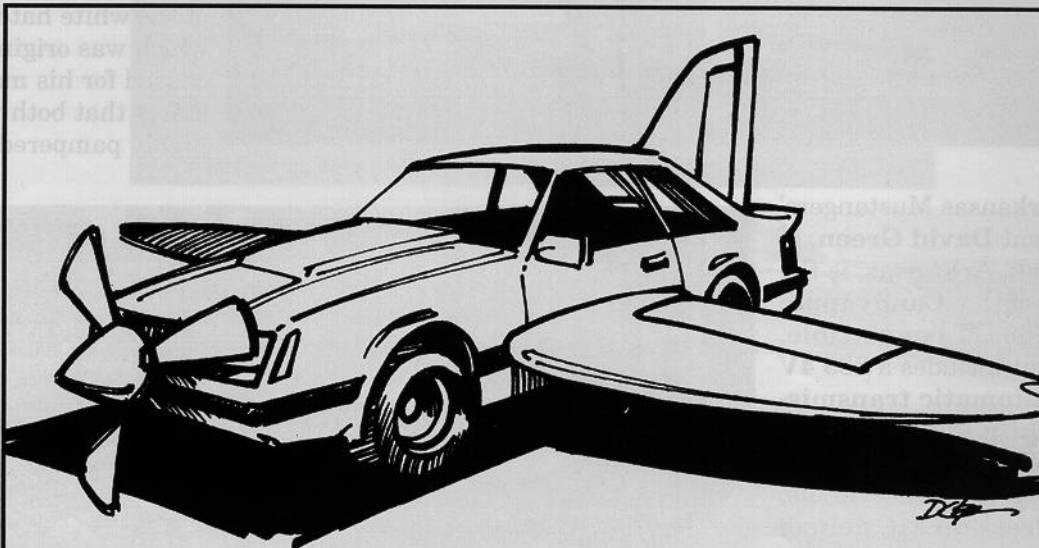

We recently received the following information from Jim Bright, Public Affairs Manager for Ford Motor Company --

The U.S. Postal Service has announced that it is considering a commemorative stamp of the 1965 Mustang as part of its "Tribute to the '60s". Starting May 1 ballots will be available at your local post office so that you may cast a vote for America's pioneer pony car. The voting process will close on May 30. Mustang will compete against five other proposed stamps in the 1960s lifestyle category. They are "Everyone Twist", "Barbie Doll Steps Out", "The Peace Symbol", "Shopping Malls", and "The Mod Look".
